A. membership" is still a sticking point. Leslie has emailed statewide DOC Volunteer Coordinator in an effort to get this impossible condition waived. She has gotten zero action on it from Cambridge Springs staffers. No response from Crawford County area chair on whether they can/will take over that jail.
- Answering Service: Eric was present. All is going well. The current bill is \$105.82.
- **Meeting Schedules**: Colin was present. November schedules have been distributed to District meetings and are available here today. There is one box of schedules left.
- Activities: Terri was present.
 - All funds have been calculated for the Anniversary Dinner: ticket sales \$1,800 50/50 sales \$228 total income \$2,028 total expenses \$3,291.06 for a net loss of \$1,263.06
 - o We are actively recruiting new chairs and event chairs for Old Timers and Anniversary Dinner.
 - Jeff will start recruiting a co-chair for golf scramble.
- **Public Information**: Rosanna was present. She is producing the agenda, dates and location for the workshop she is planning for Public information. She reached out to Tammy D. in Area 60. Two dates in mind: January 14 or Feb. 25. Opinion was to have the meeting sooner than later, in January. We will aim for January 14. update workshop 14th of January.
