

**Minutes**  
**Erie Area Central Committee**  
**Meeting Date: 12/2/2025**

The meeting was opened by Jeff at 7:00, leading us in the Serenity Prayer.

- **Secretary's Report:** Report was printed and posted to the website. Motion to accept November 2025 minutes by John; seconded by Eric. All in favor.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Reports were distributed prior. Motion to accept November 2025 reports by Jeff; seconded by John. All in favor.

**Committee Report**

- **Jails:** Leslie was not present. Jail meetings ongoing. Leslie is working on some questions about lack of inmate attendance. She will also be sitting in on a Zoom Meeting on 12/3/2025 with Lawyers Concerned for Lawyers (LCL) – which provides assistance to impaired lawyers – on the topic of AA cooperation with LCL. She will report on this afterwards.
- **Answering Service:** Eric was present. All is going well; there was a slight increase in calls over the past month. The December bill was paid for \$128.53.
- **Meeting Schedules:** Tahia was not present. Tahia is looking for a replacement and cannot continue with her service. Jeff has reached out to Jane for assistance. Once everything is finalized, Jeff will send the order over to Emerald for printing.
- **Activities:** Terri was not present. We are actively looking for a replacement chair for this committee. John has confirmed the date for the Big Book Study as March 7<sup>th</sup> at the New Hope Presbyterian Church. There was a discussion on the food for the event. The thought would be to have Danishes and coffee for breakfast and baked chicken from Walmart for lunch with several volunteers bringing sides. There was a motion to charge \$5 admission, to include food and a chance at a door prize which would be admission to the Spring Conference. The anticipated attendance would be 100 tickets. Dan accepted the motion, seconded by Jeff, all in favor. We discussed setting a budget of \$1,000 for the event. Dan made a motion to update the ticket sales to \$5 prior to February 28th and \$10 at the door, seconded by Alyssa, all in favor.
- **Public Information:** Alyssa was present. Alyssa has set her budget of \$800 for 2026. There is a new event at Cambridge Spring in 2026 that she would like to add to the schedule. Alyssa will dig further into the event for all proper clearances and details.
- **Detox:** John was not present. All is going well and there are plenty of volunteers asking to help.
- **Literature:** Chris C. was present. All is going well.
- **Website:** Judy was not present.
